Aloha,

Maui Green & Beautiful would be so honored to receive a Ten Thousand (\$10,000) grant from The Laurence H. Dorcy Hawaiian Foundation.

The mission statement for Maui Green & Beautiful is: "Caring for the Aina Through Preservation, Protection & Education".

Since the August, 2023, fires - Maui Green & Beautiful has been asked to share their knowledge of what type of trees need to be planted in the fire zones.

If we receive the grant, the funds would be used to reprint five hundred (500) copies of the 3rd edition of the "Maui County Planting Plan", adopted by the County of Maui in 2016. All three editions of the Maui County Planting Plan was originally created by long-time, beloved Maui arborist, Ernie Rezens. This last edition of the planting plan took him over ten years

to write and edit (volunteer time) and is over 250 pages. The Maui County Planting Plan is used by design and landscape professionals, arborists, government agencies, home gardeners and the community. The 500 copies would be distributed to Lahaina and Kula residents affected by the Maui fires to replant their properties, local arborists and elected officials.

The purpose of this Planting Plan is to share the knowledge and information as to the types of native Hawaiian plants and trees that should be planted in and around the County of Maui. Planting the right tree or plant in the right place. This Planting Plan will be a great gift to all of those who would receive it.

Also, Maui Green & Beautiful has been asked to support the upcoming “ ‘Ulu Festival ” scheduled for September, 2024. Since the fires, this event will be very important to the local community as the ‘ulu tree is significant historically, culturally and as an important food commodity for the community. Maui Green & Beautiful would purchase many ‘ulu trees to be given away for those who would use this very important and nutritional food.

Again, we would be honored to receive a \$10,000 grant from The Laurence H. Dorcy Hawaiian Foundation.
